AGREED MOTION TO MODIFY BRIEFING SCHEDULE ON DEFENDANT MADISON-KIPP CORPORATION'S MOTION FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT

Plaintiffs, Kathleen McHugh and Deanna Schneider, individually and on behalf of all others similarly situated, by and through their undersigned attorneys, move this Court to modify by thirteen (13) days the briefing schedule on the motion for summary judgment (Doc. 147) filed by Defendant Madison-Kipp Corporation ("MKC"). In support of this motion, which is agreed to by MKC, Plaintiffs state as follows:

1. On February 19, 2013, MKC filed a motion for summary judgment (Doc. 147). MKC's summary judgment motion is supported by a 38 page memorandum (Doc. 160) and thousands of pages of materials, including affidavits, declarations, documents, expert reports and deposition excerpts (see, Docs. 148, 149, 152, 155, 161).

2. Under the briefing schedule which is currently in effect as to MKC's motion,

Plaintiffs' response brief is due on March 12, 2013 and MKC's reply brief is due on March 22,

2013.

3. Given the large volume of materials involved with MKC's motion, and to allow

Plaintiffs to depose an expert MKC relies upon in its motion but who is not available for

deposition until after March 12, Plaintiffs are in need of a short extension to file their response

brief. Plaintiffs request that they be allowed an additional thirteen (13) days, to and including

March 25, 2013, in which to file their summary judgment response brief.

4. MKC's counsel (John Busch) has been consulted about this proposed extension

and agrees to it. MKC is further agreeable to filing its summary judgment reply brief ten (10)

days after Plaintiffs file their response brief, on or before April 4, 2013.

5. Based on the above, Plaintiffs respectfully request that this Court enter an order

modifying the briefing schedule on MKC's summary judgment schedule such that Plaintiffs'

response brief is due on March 25, 2013 and MKC's reply brief is due on April 4, 2013.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiffs respectfully request that this Court enter an order modifying

the briefing schedule on MKC's summary judgment motion as set forth above.
